There is a huge variety of museums, exhibitions, churches, and monuments in the city of cultural and scientific value. There is something for everyone.

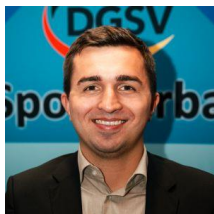
In 2015 Hanover was host for the European Deaf Football Championships for men and women. This important deafsports event was widely recognized and one of the most successful in Germany.

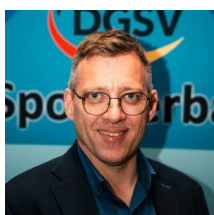

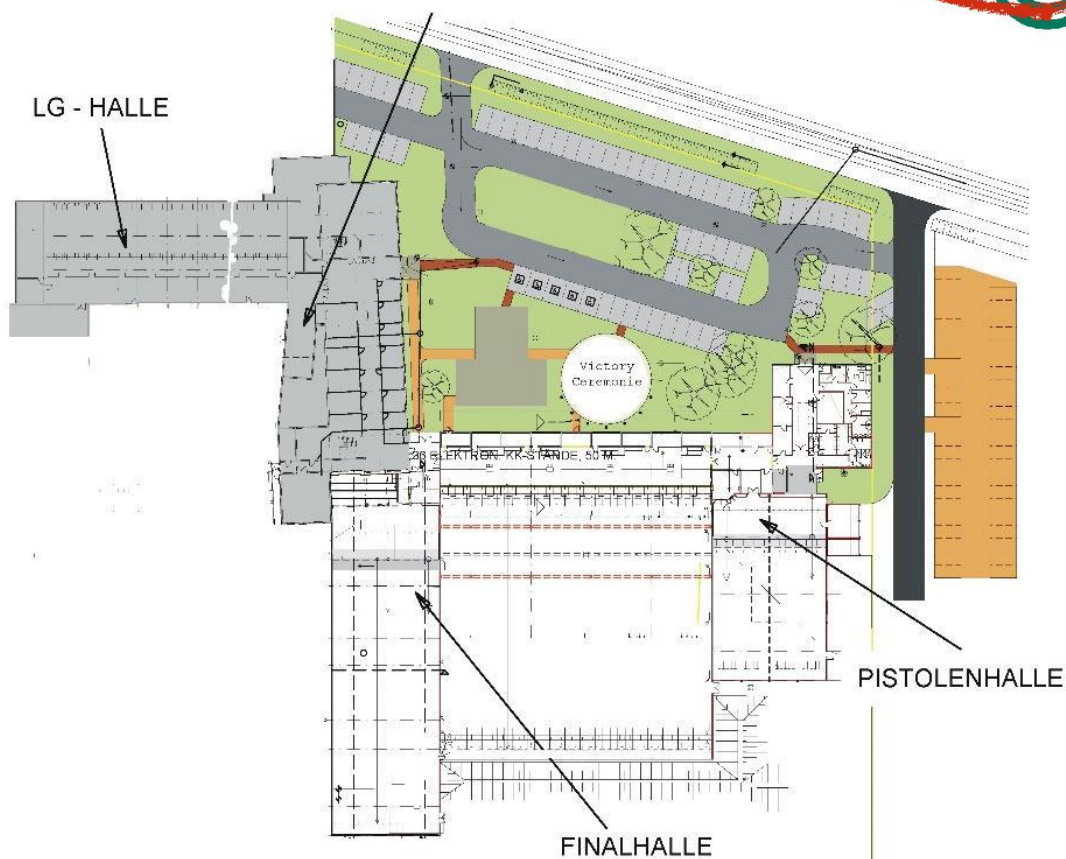
